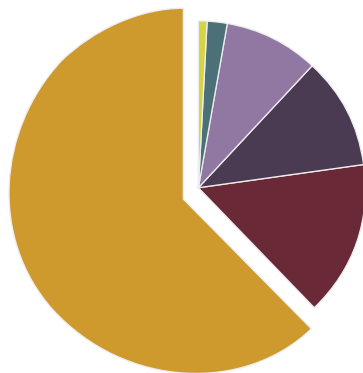


DALLIN PTO BY THE NUMBERS

Without the Dallin PTO, our children's education would look a lot different. Dallin's PTO provides educational enrichment, school-wide and classroom materials, and community events and resources. Last school year (2018-2019), the majority of the PTO's \$71,000 budget was directed toward **curricular enhancement and programs** for all Dallin students, including:

- **School-wide projects** using shared texts to teach inclusivity, multicultural experiences, and empathy
- **Grade-level programming** including Aquarium Touch Tank, Discovery Museums Sound Session, Animal Adventures, Menotomy Day, Japanese Food Day
- **Field trip costs** for every student in every grade, adding depth to classroom learning
- **Technology resources** such as DreamBox and RAZKids
- New Makers Cart and Art, Music, Wellness, and Digital Citizenship materials
- 392 new books for the school library



Spending 2018-2019



The work of Dallin PTO is made possible through the support of the Dallin community.

More than 100 parents/family members volunteered across two dozen subcommittees last year. There are many ways to make a difference at Dallin.

In 2018-2019, Dallin PTO fundraising resulted in \$40,000 in revenues. Over 125 generous families contributed \$12,500 to the Dallin Annual Fund. Another \$12,500 was earmarked from the Spring 2018 biannual auction, together representing nearly 2/3 of overall revenue.

As we look ahead, Dallin PTO's financial reserves are now at \$45,000, requiring ongoing fundraising to match the level of curriculum enhancement and community investment of recent years. Our goal is for 150 families to support the annual fund this year and host a successful auction in Spring 2020.
